RATIONALE

Life Saving Patrols form a large section of the club's objectives. It is our core function. The City of Bunbury Surf Life Saving Club wishes to recognise members who have completed the majority of their hours as per the club's Life Saving Agreement and their patrol roster.

APPLICATION OF DISCOUNT

Refer to Policy 1.4 – Under definition 3.

VALUE

A member who completes a minimum of 20 hours of patrol will receive a 10% discount to their membership fee for the following season.

For individual members, the discount is applied directly to their fee. [E.g.: using the fees of season 2020/21, an active membership fee of \$175.00 would be discounted to \$157.50 for the following season.]

Family Fee members: if one member completes the required minimum hours, the family will receive the 10% discount. If two or more members complete 20 hours each, it is still a 10% discount to the Family Fee. [E.g.: a family fee of \$350.00 will be discounted to \$315.00 if one or more members of that family each complete a minimum of 20 hours.]

ELIGIBLE PATROL HOURS

Only hours conducted as part of a rostered patrol (as per the Patrol Service Agreement for that season) will be considered. These can include hours completed as Patrol Rostered, Make-up, Substitute and Voluntary. Hours will be recorded onto Surfguard via the patrol app or written patrol logs.

Hours that will not be considered include water safety conducted at events (E.g.: triathlons, swim thru's), Woodside Nipper water safety, junior training water safety, other internal or external event water safety.

ELIGIBLE MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

- Cadet Member (13 15 years)
- Active (15 18 years)
- Active (18 years and over)
- Active Reserve
- Long Service
- Award Member
- Family Membership that includes one of the above

APPLICATION OF DISCOUNT

The Director of Life Saving and City of Bunbury SLSC administration staff will vet Surfguard prior to the upcoming season for eligible members. Members will be contacted to advise them of the discount and how they can apply it to their membership in the next season.

Members who believe that they have completed 20 patrol hours can ask for verification. Any discrepancies will be finalised by the Board of Management.
